

VISUAL ARTS

- Use a different technique of visual arts for each page.
- Make individual posters of each child representing him/her as an animal of the story.
- Make a hen as a mobile out of recycled materials or "papier maché".
- Make a puppet for each child to give a play based on the story
- Make a picture of the animals out of seeds to be glued.

MATHS

- Recognize numbers up to 10
- Associate a quantity with a number.
- Make an algorithm of 3.
- Recognize, name and draw the main geometrical shapes.
- Locating oneself: below, behind...
- Chronology: put in order pictures of a story.

READING

- Learn vowels in different prints.
- Hear the sound "a" at the beginning of a word and within a word.
- Hear syllables like "MA" or "PA" and study the association vowel-consonant.
- Order letters to make a word.
- Order words to make a sentence.
- Recognize some words.
- Compose a sentence with words

LANGUAGE

- Learn how to tell a story.
- Make a play with the story
- Study the words related to bees and other animals of the story.
- Debate about robbery and morality
